### KEY PASSAGE: 1 CORINTHIANS 3:5B-15 (NLT)

Each of us did the work the Lord **gave** us.

<sup>6</sup> **I planted** the seed in your hearts, and **Apollos watered** it, but it was **God who made it grow**.

<sup>7</sup> It's not important who does the planting, or who does the watering. What's **important** is that God makes the seed grow. <sup>8</sup> The one who plants and the one who waters **work together** with the **same purpose**. And both will be **rewarded** for their own hard work. <sup>9</sup> For we are both God's workers. And you are God's field. You are God's building.

<sup>10</sup> Because of God's grace to me, I have laid the **foundation** like an expert builder. Now others are building on it. But whoever is building on this foundation must be very careful. <sup>11</sup> For no one can lay any foundation other than the one we already have—Jesus Christ.

<sup>12</sup> Anyone who builds on that foundation may use a variety of materials—gold, silver, jewels, wood, hay, or straw. <sup>13</sup> But on the judgment day, **fire will reveal what kind of work each builder has done**. The fire will show if a person's work has **any value**. <sup>14</sup> If the work survives, that builder will receive a **reward**.

<sup>15</sup> But if the work is burned up, the builder will suffer great **loss**. The builder will be saved, but like someone **barely escaping** through a wall of flames.
